WWAC is a non-governmental accreditation, extended exclusively to private, Christian institutions upon inspection and approval of their programs, operations, and integrity.

WWAC is a worldwide accreditation that honors the

separation of church and state, and extends beyond national boundaries. Its standards and expectations measure compliance with scriptural principles as applied to education.

The purpose of accreditation is to:

A) certify that an institution has met the established standards of excellence

B) assist prospective students in identifying reputable institutions, which offer degree programs that will meet their needs and goals

C) allow institutions to evaluate the acceptability of transfer credits into their own curricula programs

The heart of this ministry is to see growth and financial freedom for churches. You can either study through

Confess the Truth Constantly

Nothing is perfect except Your words. Oh, how I love them. I think about them all day long. They make me wiser than my enemies, because they are my constant guide.

- Psalm 119:96-98

It is important for us to know that we should never allow our mouths to speak anything that is contrary to God's Word. We need to confess the truth constantly because nothing is perfect except the Word of God.

Confess that the Word of God is your meditation day and night. Psalm 19:14 says, *Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in Thy sight, O Lord, my strength and my redeemer.*

Confess this from Psalm 1: "Lord, because I meditate on Your Word day and night, Your Word says that I am like a tree - a strong tree. My roots go down deep, Lord God, and reach the sustenance and the power of the Water of Life that the world knows nothing about. I am like a tree planted by the rivers of water. I confess Your truth constantly!"
